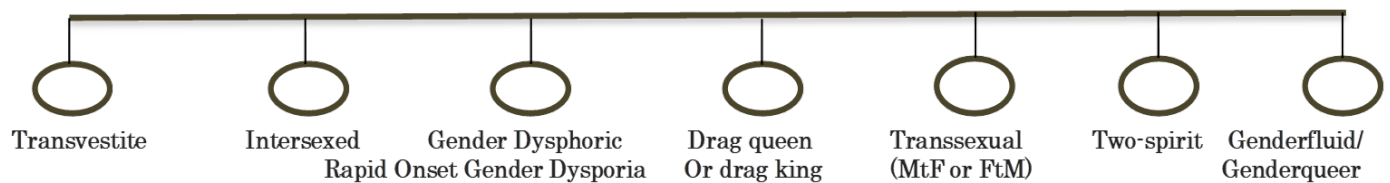


Gender Dysphoria:

*The feeling that one's emotional and psychological identity as male or female
Is opposite to one's biological sex¹*

(2013) **0.005-0.014%** of Adult men; **0.002-0.003%** of Adult women
Prior to **2006** - 88% of girls/97% of boys reverted to biological design

Transgendered Spectrum

The transgender child' newly constructed category of person

Claims:

- **Biological sex is socially constructed**
- **Born into the wrong body**
- **Medical gender transitioning is a human right**
- **Transgender people are oppressed**
- **Transgender movement myth:**
- **Men and women are a different species of human being²**

Assigned? Promote that gender is not **aligned with biological (assigned) sex** at birth – someone made a mistake!

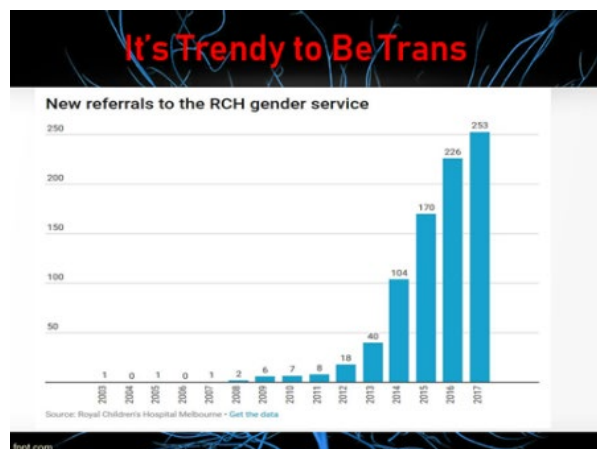
- assignment is only relevant to **intersex individuals**

Sex Differential – over 6500 protein-coding genes; sex-biased gene expressions³

Rapid Onset Gender Dysphoria – 85% girls; Coming out in clusters⁴

Trendy: 2010 – 0.014%; **2017 – 0.7**

- Tavistock Psychology Clinic in London, England: **104% increase 2015**
- **97 referrals – 2009; over 2,000 in 2017.**⁵

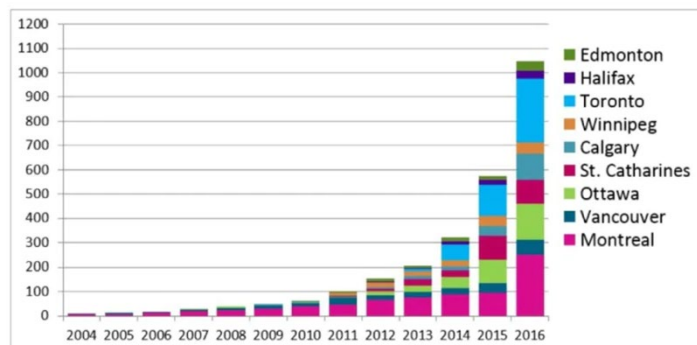

Transgender – recent designation ... NOT medical or scientific: social/cultural

Institutionalizing Ideology? Billionaires, pharmaceuticals & governments –millions

- Body integrity identity disorder⁹
 - Because of attention it draws 31%
 - In order to be disabled and have others help me 6%
 - In order to feel whole, complete, set right again 77%
 - In order to feel sexually excited 67%
 - In order to feel satisfied inside 83%

Process of amputation is the main focus of desire

Alexithymia – extreme dysfunction in emotional awareness; **social attachment**¹⁰

- Difficulty identifying different types of feelings
- Limited understanding of what causes feelings
- Difficulty expressing feelings
- Difficulty recognizing facial cues in others
- Limited or rigid imagination
- Constricted style of thinking
- Hypersensitive to physical sensations
- Detached or tentative connection to others

Detransitioners - speaking out -dysphoria same or worse after transitioning¹¹

Root issues ignored – created more emotional pain
